Getting Up Again is the author's personal and inspiring account of his unemployment experience and how he used it to find destiny and fulfillment in life. After six years at a fast growing software company, he was laid off when the business was sold to a larger competitor. The resulting story is a witty, humorous and genuine expression of the feelings that emerge from the roller coaster ride of unemployment.
